



ALCOHOL SERVICE POLICY

Valid I.D. is required for purchase.
A guest that appears to be 30 years of age or younger must produce a valid form of acceptable identification.

Acceptable forms of valid United States identification for alcoholic beverage purchases are:
driver's license, passport, state issued I.D. card with photo, military I.D. with photo

Government warning: according to the Surgeon General, women should not drink alcoholic beverages during pregnancy because of the risk of birth defects.

There is a 2 alcoholic beverage limit,
per person, per identification.

Alcohol service will be discontinued at management discretion.

All guests must be 21 years of age
to purchase an alcoholic beverage.
